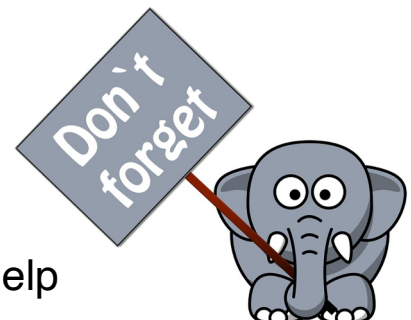

# LETTER FROM OUR PRESIDENT

Hello Quilters,

Hope you are finding ways to stay cool in this crazy hot weather.... And there was a good one this past weekend: watching the online Global Quilt Connection Platter that our Guild subscribed to on July 30 and 31st. This weekend event did not disappoint! If you missed it, or haven't taken advantage of these snippets of quilting-related info in the past, let me explain what to expect. Over two days, in 3 hours each day, various 15-minute YouTube sessions are shown by a variety of quilting educators. There is a wide variety of topics and interesting information. If you watch live, you get to ask the presenter questions about their topic. But if you can't attend the live sessions (typically held at 3-6 pm on Saturday and Sunday), each is available for 48 hours following the original presentations. This also gives you the opportunity to replay sessions that you want to revisit, play the sessions at faster (or slower) speed if that works for you, and select/skip the sessions depending on your interest.

I enjoyed every one of the sessions this month—we learned a little bit about thread painting, using vintage linens in projects, stained glass designs, dying fabric, using scraps, couching, improv, and so much more.

For me, one of the highlights was the last session on Sunday; it was titled “Shoot Your Quilt” with hints on photographing your quilt for marketing it to a show or customer. I was tempted to skip it (you may know that I am not one to actually finish a quilt!) but stuck with it, and was pleasantly surprised at how much the cell-phone camera techniques transitioned to all photos. The presenter mentioned several times how these techniques transition to taking the best pictures of grandkids—now there's a skill I can definitely utilize! Another highlight was the concept of making a quilt background with scraps--something to try sometime for sure!

While the presentations are short and limited in time, the concepts are generally complete enough to pique your interest to give it a try. However, the ultimate benefit of these presentations is the possibility that we hear about topics we want to learn more about. The hosts are generally available to do zoom presentations, on demand shows, and guild meetings. Therefore, it is helpful if you share your reactions with our Program Chair, Kathy Shorter, to give her input on presentations you might like to have our guild book for future meetings.

I hope you all will mark your calendars for the next set of GQC Samplers on September 17 and 18. They announced the dates (changed from the original October dates) and the topic of “Holiday Projects.” I'm looking forward to these! Who can't use more quick project ideas for gifts and holiday décor!

Time is running out! Quilt show registration forms **MUST be in to Kerry Kastle by September 1<sup>st</sup>**. That date will be here before you know it! If you are putting into the quilt show something from a Saturday Special or KQ workshop, you **MUST** fill out a registration form and submit to Kerry.

The best and easiest way to do this is to fill out your registration form, attach your 2 pictures and hand that off to Kerry at the August KQ Trunk Show at Molasses Creek (8/14/22, 2:00 p.m.).

Registration forms must be either mailed or hand delivered to Kerry.....no e-mailing them!!

Also.....you can bring your quilt raffle ticket money and hand it in to Kerry at the August trunk show! By selling quilt raffle tickets you are really helping the guild!

Please keep working on your boutique items as well as items for the chance drawing!

Our last quilt show meeting will be held via ZOOM on **Monday, September 19, 2022 at 7 p.m.** All committee heads NEED to be in attendance. This is a very important meeting where we finalize our plans for the quilt show! I will be sending out a ZOOM invite a few days before the meeting.

Don't forget – these are the dates –

**Tuesday, October 11, 2022** – Quilt drop off 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. If you have a quilt registered for the quilt show, it MUST be dropped off on Tuesday. If that presents a problem for you, you will need to find a friend to drop off your quilt!

**Wednesday, October 12, 2022** – Judging Day. Times will be announced shortly.

**Thursday, October 13, 2022** – Hanging the quilt show. Times will be announced shortly. **Friday, October 14, 2022 - Quilt Show 10 to 6.**

**Saturday, October 15, 2022** – Quilt show 10 to 4.

Quilt Pickup begins at 5 p.m. Please consider coming out early to help take down the show!

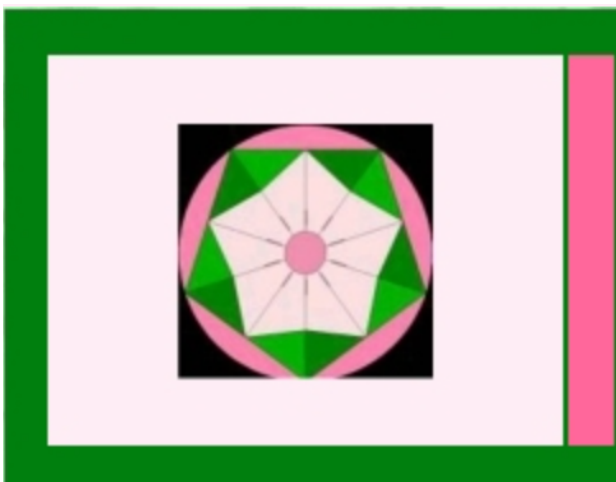


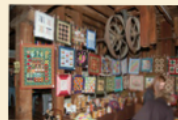
